## Reporting To School and Child Care

We request that if our child is absent, that you call in and let us know of illnesses, vacation days, etc. If you are enrolled in the Child Care program, you will be charged for your scheduled days regardless of attendance.

When calling in for reasons of sickness, please let us know if your child is contagious with any kind of communicable disease such as chicken pox, strep throat etc.... So that we can take precautionary measures. Please refer to the “Parent Handbook” in the back, for the communicable disease section. Communicable Disease Posters are located in the school hallways to refer to also.

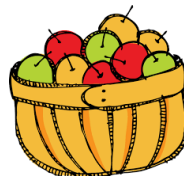
## Tuition Payment and Child Care Fee’s

According to your payment schedules that coincide with the program your child is enrolled in, all payments are due the first of every month for Kindergarten and Preschool. See the “Parent Handbook” for the charges after the 10th of every month. You are not billed for Kindergarten or Preschool, but you are billed for the Child Care, one week after the service is rendered. Billing invoices are placed in your child’s locker for the Child Care service.

A “Tuition Box” is located outside the Administrator’s Office if you are making a payment after 3 p.m., you may hand your payment to a teacher, or you can also pay by mail (1400 Concordia Drive) credit cards are accepted now as well.

Be sure to place your child’s name in the memo section of your check and also the program to which you are paying along with the payment coupon.

## Parking

In regard to parking lot concerns and your child’s safety, we would like to ask the following things of you: Parents bring their children to Preschool should park out front in the church parking lot.

Please do not “stand” where the bus turn around/handicap ramps are. To avoid injuries, please do not allow your children to climb on the Redeemer Lutheran stone sign in front of the building, also do not allow your child to “swing” on the railings of the steps out front.

Parents bringing children to Child Care should use the left side parking lot entrance.

When arriving or dismissing, all the children should be with their parents (hand held if need be) **walking** through the church narthex and out into the parking lot. We have had some close calls in the past, of children getting hit by a car or bus because of “running ahead” of mom/dad or babysitter. **All children have to be supervised please!** Thank you for your anticipated understanding and assistance in keeping everyone safe!
