Religion Curriculum is called "One in Christ" from Concordia Publishing House. It consists of Bible stories, verses and activities to reiterate the word of God each and every day of the week. We use lesson leaflets, story cubes, puppets and so on, to implement each day's lesson.

Academic Benchmarks are met through our curriculum. We recognize the Ohio Department of Education benchmarks and teach the Common Core / Standards for each subject matter in our curriculum.
