Our Kindergarten room is bright and cheerful looking and invites the children in for a wonderful time of learning. It features an outdoor exit to the wooded playground area which is spacious, completely fenced in and a great place for large muscle play. The Kindergarten room is lined with windows to observe God's wonderful creations of deer, squirrels and birds of all kinds. We feature a great atmosphere for learning about nature and of God's many blessings.

We use "One in Christ" from Concordia Publishing House for our religious curriculum. It consists of Bible stories, verses and activities to reiterate the word of God each and every day of the week. We use lesson leaflets, story cubes, puppets and other creative methods, to implement each day's lesson.

Academic Benchmarks are met through our curriculum. We recognize the Ohio Department of Education benchmarks and teach the Common Core Standards for each subject matter in our curriculum.

The Kindergarten Class, will take several field trips which are scheduled according to outside units and seasonal changes. Educational trips can coincide with classroom studies.

Chapel is scheduled with Pastor Davidson in the Church Sanctuary several times each month. A short lesson, mission news, chapel offerings and songs are shared at this special time with Pastor.

Speech, Hearing and Vision Screenings are offered at the beginning of each school year. Special events and activities according to holidays are held as well.
